# Atlantic City Style

In the early 1800's Atlantic City was nothing but sand, marshes and wilderness snuggled off the coast of NJ. In 1850, an entrepreneur and an engineer saw the potential in the island, invested in a railroad connecting Camden and the Resort, and gave us the official name, "Atlantic City".

By 1860, 700 residents called Atlantic City their home. A roadway connecting the mainland to the island was completed in 1870, and luxurious hotels began to sprout along the beach. That same year the wooden planked boardwalk was designed to keep beach sand out of the fine hotels and trains. Built with reinforced steel and concrete, the historic boardwalk extended 7 miles, until the 1944 hurricane. The Boardwalk remains the largest in the world, measuring 4.1 miles long, and 60 feet wide, and extends from Atlantic City, stretches through the City of Ventnor and ends at Margate City's border. In 1878 the rail line connecting AC to Philadelphia was complete, and the city opened officially in 1880. In 1882, the Ocean Pier was the first amusement pier to be built protruding off the boardwalk. Still operating today is the Steel Pier built in 1898. The Auditorium Pier opened in 1899, and in 1906 became Steeplechase. That same year the Million Dollar Pier opened, which is now The Shops at Caesars. The Atlantic City Historical Society and the Arts Center, sit on the old site of the Garden Pier, built 1913. The Heinz Pier, formerly the Iron Pier, located east of the Garden Pier, and west of Steel Pier, was destroyed in the 1944 Hurricane.
